

Sustainable harvest cut of seabuckthorn

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Harvesting of seabuckthorn by cut of whole branches affects the further growth and vegetative regeneration of bushes. The purpose of presentation is to offer a sustainable way of harvest cut, that along with high harvest value allows keeping vitality of bushes and their ability to replace the lost branches.

Three main principles of cut harvest are commented:

1. Cut branches must be three years old.
2. Removed part of leaves should not exceed 50 % of the whole canopy.
3. Cut method should promote activation and development of adventitious buds.

Selection of cut branches is explained and shown.
